The New Zealand River Trust was established in 2013 and the New Zealand River Awards are the primary vehicle for delivering on the Trust's objectives. The objectives of the Awards are to:

- Encourage greater community participation in measuring and reporting water quality
- Highlight the actions being taken to restore freshwater health.
