Your Food and Fibre Sector 101.

The **Engage Programme** was designed and developed by **Rural Leaders** in conjunction with Lincoln University, and with support from the Ministry for the Environment.

Engage is as much for those without a background in agriculture as it is those who seek to refresh their sector knowledge. It is particularly suited to people entering, or connecting with, the Food and Fibre Sector in advisory, regulatory, or farmer-focused policy roles.

Engage equips participants with the skills and understanding to succeed and the confidence to engage with food and fibre stakeholders. This 3-day immersive introduction helps participants develop a deeper understanding of the NZ Food and Fibre Sector and how it is connected to the global economy.
